EA4. Fasting in Secret so as Not to Impress Others.

We are to fast in secret so as not to impress others.

This precept is derived from His Word (blessed is He):

Key New Testament Scriptures

Matthew 6:16-18

Now when you fast, don't go around looking miserable, like the hypocrites. They make sour faces so that people will know they are fasting. Yes! I tell you, they have their reward already!

¹⁷ But you, when you fast, wash your face and groom yourself, so that no one will know you are fasting- except your Father, who is with you in secret. Your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.
