JA3. Not Fearing Those Who Would Oppose, Persecute or Harm Us.

We are not to fear those who would oppose, persecute, or harm us.

JA3a: We are not to fear those who would oppose us. JA3b: We are not to fear those who would persecute us. JA3c: We are not to fear those who would harm us.

This precept is derived from His Word (blessed is He):

Key New Testament Scriptures

John 12:42-43

Nevertheless, many of the leaders did trust in him; but because of the P'rushim they did not say so openly, out of fear of being banned from the synagogue; for they loved praise from other people more than praise from God.

Philippians 1:27-28

Only conduct your lives in a way worthy of the Good News of the Messiah; so that whether I come and see you or I hear about you from a distance, you stand firm, united in spirit, fighting with one accord for the faith of the Good News, not frightened by anything the opposition does. This will be for them an indication that they are headed for destruction and you for deliverance. And this is from God;

Hebrews 13:6

Therefore, we say with confidence, "ADONAI is my helper; I will not be afraid-what can a human being do to me?"

Revelation 2:10

Don't be afraid of what you are about to suffer. Look, the Adversary is going to have some of you thrown in prison, in order to put you to the test; and you will face an ordeal for ten days. Remain faithful, even to the point of death; and I will give you life as your crown.
